Job Summary

The Utility Department's Maintenance Technician is responsible for performing semi-skilled and unskilled work in the installation, maintenance, and repair of water and wastewater pipe lines and fixtures. Work involves locating water and sewer problems and water and sewer lines; installing, maintaining, and repairing water and wastewater lines and fixtures; and maintaining equipment. Employee is subjected to the usual hazards of working with water and sewer problems.

Essential Job Functions (Must be performed with or without accommodation)

- Employee will be required to assist other Departments within his/her essential job functions as departmental staffing levels dictate.
- Job position requires working in inclement weather conditions and weekly on call rotation for weekend and after hour callouts.
- Adhere to all City policies and procedures as outlined in the Employee Handbook, in particular:
 - Attendance Policy
 - All Safety Policies and Procedures
 - Appropriate business casual attire for office personnel and proper uniform attire for those departments that are so designated (Police, Fire, and Public Works Departments);
- Assists in the repair of damaged water and sewer lines, and replacing water/sewer pipe, as necessary;
- Conducts routine maintenance of water and sewer lines;
- Prepares trenches for new lines by hand digging and by using front bucket of backhoe;
- Installs water and sewer taps; installs and repairs fire hydrants, water meters, and water valves, and raises or replaces manhole rings and covers;
- Unearths, repairs and replaces main sewer lines and sewer connections; repairs and replaces manholes;
- Operates one or more types of heavy motorized equipment; i.e., front end loaders, farm tractors, rubber tire backhoes, packers, underground bowering equipment etc; Also, has responsibility of operating dump trucks and light trucks,
- Insures quality of work through visual and mechanical inspection;
- Assures work is completed in a timely and professional manner;
- Cleans and maintains equipment and tools;
- Paints fire hydrants, as required and necessary;

- Performs custodial duties in Department facilities and vehicles;
- Repairs barricades and fences
- Resurface and fill roadways, driveways, and yards;
- · May perform masonry and carpentry work in support of maintenance and repair work; and,
- Performs all other work as assigned.
